2 New Elementary Schools for Charlottetown

\$64.9M over 5 years

To meet the most urgent capacity needs, new, net-zero ready schools will be built in both East and West Royalty, with space for 650 students at each site.

East Royalty and West Royalty will receive net-zero ready schools with capacity for 650 students each. ”

Georgetown School Replacement

\$10M over 5 years

To replace the elementary school with a new facility to provide a modern learning environment to support innovative teaching methods.

\$16.8M over 4 years

Phase one of a completed needs assessment-based major renovation.

Queen Charlotte Expansion

\$18.9M over 3 years

To add over 20,000 square feet of learning space as well as meeting rooms, updated mechanical systems, and green building initiatives.



School Revitalization Fund

\$16M over 3 years

To continue the multi-year, \$22M commitment, started in Fall 2023 which will address urgent needs such as classroom upgrades, learning space improvements, and accessibility enhancements, ensuring that every school in PEI is a safe, modern place to learn.
