(d) conducting an environmental site inspection of the lot;

(e) reviewing an application for the subdivision of the lot into more than two parcels of land or an application for the subdivision of the lot where known environmentally sensitive features exist, such as a watercourse, a wetland or a sand dune.

2. An application for a property inspection is set out in the Schedule to schedule these regulations.
