**GREETING**  
**A PROCLAMATION**

**BOARD ORDER: DFPEI 2010-08**

**EFFECTIVE: 1 November 2010**

Under the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations and under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N-3, Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

**MARKETING ORDER**

Application

1. This Order applies to the control and regulation of the production and marketing of milk in the province of Prince Edward Island.

Definitions

2. The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the *Natural Products Marketing Act* and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations and in this Order:

(a) "Dairy year" shall mean a twelve month period from August 1<sup>st</sup> in one year to July 31<sup>st</sup> in the next succeeding year.

(b) "Department" shall mean the Prince Edward Island Department of Agriculture.

(c) "Quota" means a producer's share of the market for milk products as determined by the Board and assigned to a producer by the Board.

(d) "Quota days" are the number of days from the last day milk is delivered to a processor in the previous month to the last day milk is delivered to a processor in the current month.

Daily quota

3. Quota assigned by the Board to a registered quota holder shall be expressed in kilograms of butterfat per day rounded to two decimal places.

Minimum

Quota Holding

4. A producer must hold a minimum of 10 Kg of daily quota to market milk. Producers who hold less than 10 Kg of daily quota as of 31 December 2009 may continue to market milk based on their quota holdings as of that date or if they increase their quota holdings after that date, but may not market milk if they sell or transfer any portion of their quota. Exceptions may be considered by the Board only if a producer intends to market all milk from his farm through on farm processing.

## Monthly quota

5. The amount of quota available to a registered quota holder that markets milk in a calendar month shall be equal to their daily quota multiplied by the number of Quota Days in the month rounded to the nearest kilogram of butterfat.

However, if milk was not shipped on the last pickup or pickups in a month, the following procedures apply. If quota days are less than the current month's calendar days minus one, then quota days are the difference in the number of days from the last day milk was delivered to a processor in the previous month to the last calendar day in the current month. When calendar days are used, the last day of the month is deemed to be the last pickup date for the month for the next month's quota day calculations.

## Quota credit system

6. Recognizing that milk producers efforts to fill their daily quota shall result in production either slightly above or slightly below their monthly quota, the Board shall allow milk producers to over ship up to a maximum of ten (10) times their daily quota on a cumulative basis, referred to as Over Quota Production Credits, or to under ship up to a maximum of twenty (20) times their daily quota on a cumulative basis, referred to as Under Quota Production Credits. The maximum number of days used in calculating a producer's Under Quota Production Credits shall increase by one each month from 1 November 2010 until it reaches thirty as of 1 August 2011.

## Maximum over quota production credits

(1) The maximum number of over quota production credits available to a milk producer shall be determined by the Board by multiplying a milk producer's daily quota holdings at the end of a month by ten.

## Maximum under /quota production credits

(2) The maximum number of under quota production credits available to a milk producer shall be determined by the Board by multiplying a milk producer's daily quota holdings at the end of a month by the number of days as determined in section 6 (above).

## Idem

(3) A milk producer shipping slightly under quota in a month shall be allowed to offset all or part of the under production against Over Quota Production Credits carried forward from the previous month, or to carry forward the Under Quota Production Credits to future months to offset future over quota production provided that the cumulative under production of the producer does not exceed the amount as determined in section 6 (above).

## Idem

(4) A milk producer shipping slightly over quota shall be allowed to offset all or part of the over quota production against Under Quota Production Credits carried forward from the previous month or to use available Over Quota Production Credits provided that the cumulative over quota of the producer does not exceed ten (10) times the producer's daily quota.

## Responsibility for accumulated over quota production credits

(5) A milk producer shall be financially responsible to the Board for the value of all accumulated over quota production credits at the time the producer exits the industry.

## Value of over quota production credits

(6) The value of over quota production credits accumulated by a producer shall be calculated by the Board and shall equal the value of blended component returns from the All Milk Pool received by the Board for the month in which the producer is financially responsible to the Board.



Payment method	<p>(7) A producer may compensate the Board for the value of accumulated over quota production credits in any of the following manners:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(a) In the case where a producer exiting the industry by transferring his quota to a purchaser of his on-going dairy enterprise, or to a new producer relocating the quota to a non-producing farm location, the accumulated over quota production credits may be transferred to the purchaser of the quota provided the purchaser agrees to the transfer, in writing, to the Board.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">(b) In the case where a producer is exiting the industry by selling his quota on the Quota Exchange, the producer may pay the Board for the value of accumulated over quota production credits from the proceeds of quota sold.</p>
Non-payment of accumulated over quota production credits	<p>(8) Where a producer has not paid the Board for the value of accumulated over quota production credits, the Board shall deduct the value of the accumulated over quota production credits from payments due to the producer, including payments for quota sold by the producer on the Quota Exchange.</p>
Idem	<p>(9) The Board shall not approve a transfer of quota from one producer to another producer where the Board has not been compensated for the value of accumulated over quota production credits held by the transferor.</p>
Transfer of under quota production credits	<p>(10) A producer may only transfer under quota production credits to a purchaser of his on-going dairy enterprise or to an immediate family member where the Board has approved the transfer of all the quota holdings of the producer to an immediate family member.</p>
Seasonal quota incentives	<p>7.The Board may, from time to time, offer registered quota holders seasonal quota incentives to promote the delivery of additional milk required to meet seasonal demand for dairy products during certain periods of the year. Such incentives shall be temporary in nature, shall be expressed in kilograms of butterfat and shall not form part of a registered quota holder's quota holdings.</p>
Payment of levies	<p>8.No registered quota holder shall market milk without paying the fees, service charges or levies fixed by the Board.</p>
Ownership of cows and land	<p>9. No registered quota holder shall market milk that is not produced by cows owned, leased or rented by him and located on property owned, leased or rented by him.</p>
Shipments in registered name	<p>10. No registered quota holder shall ship or sell milk under the name of any other person or under any other designation. A registered quota holder must ship and sell in the name under which he has been registered, all the milk sent to market from his farm.</p>
Processors receiving milk	<p>11. No processor shall receive milk from a person who is not in possession of a registration number and a quota assigned by the Board.</p>

Quotas property of Board	12. Quotas are the property of the Board and are not transferrable between registered quota holders except as provided for in Board Orders.
Non-production	13. A registered quota holder who ceases to market milk in three consecutive calendar months shall have his quota revert to the Board.
Catastrophes	14. A registered quota holder who has reduced deliveries or discontinued production temporarily due to a catastrophe, may apply to the Board for relief from Board Orders.
Idem	(1) A catastrophe may include severe injury, severe illness or death of the registered quota holder or the person(s) responsible for the dairy herd, the sudden death or loss of a significant part of the milking herd or destruction of the production facilities.
Relief available	(2) The Board may grant a producer that has suffered a catastrophe one or both of the following:  (a) An exemption from the registered quota holder's quota reverting to the Board for a period of up to twenty-four (24) consecutive months after the catastrophe occurred, or  (b) Approval for the producer to lease all or part of the producer's daily quota to another registered quota holder(s) for a period of up to twenty-four consecutive months after the catastrophe occurred.
Catastrophe clause lease policy	(3) The Board shall establish and maintain a Catastrophe Clause Quota Leasing Policy that may be amended from time to time and the Board shall make the policy, or any amendments made thereto, available to all registered quota holders.
Lost under quota production credits	(4) The Board shall not reinstate under quota production credits lost by any producer for any reason.
Quota adjustments	15. The Board may, from time to time, adjust producer quota holdings to reflect changes in demand for dairy products. Such adjustments shall be made to the quota holdings of all registered quota holders on a pro-rata basis.
Quota reserve	16. The Board may, at its discretion, hold an amount of quota in reserve.
Transfers of quota	17. Quotas may be transferred under the following conditions:  (1) In the case of off-farm transfers, from a father to a son or daughter or from a mother to a son or daughter provided no conditions or restrictions are in effect on the quota holdings of the transferor or transferee pursuant to other sections of this Order or any other Order of the Board.  (2) To the purchaser of an on-going dairy enterprise where the purchaser is a new producer and has purchased all land, buildings, dairy equipment and all the milking herd. Such transfers shall be conditional on the producer marketing all milk from the purchased farm location for at least twenty-four consecutive months after the date of purchase or such quota shall revert to the Board.  (3) To the purchaser of an on-going dairy enterprise where the purchaser is a registered producer and has purchased all land, buildings, dairy equipment and all the milking herd, with the intent of expanding his dairy enterprise. Such transfers shall be conditional on the producer marketing all milk from the new farm location for at least twenty-four consecutive calendar months after the date of purchase or such quota transferred shall revert to the Board.

(4) To a new producer where the quota is being transferred from a retiring producer and the new producer wishes to relocate the quota to a non-producing farm location, provided that the new producer shall not be allowed to combine the quota with any other quota for at least five (5) years except as specified in Section 17 (5) (below).

(5) To a producer who has purchased quota through the Quota Exchanges operated by the Board under the Quota Exchange Order.

(6) Effective 1 November 2010, no new applications to transfer quota as specified in Section 17 (3) (above) will be accepted.

Lease equivalent to purchase

18. For the purposes of determining eligibility for a transfer of quota under sections 17(2) and 17(3) the Board may consider as equivalent to a purchase, a long term lease (five years or more) which contains an offer to purchase clause.

Prior Board approval required

19. All transfers of quota are subject to prior approval by the Board.

Quota reserve

20. Quota that has reverted to the Board due to a producer failing to comply with Board Orders shall become part of a reserve, which may be distributed by the Board to qualifying producers on a basis determined by the Board.

Processor deductions

21. Each processor shall deduct from monies payable to a producer any levies established by a Board Order and shall remit the said levies to the Board by the twentieth of the month following the month the milk was delivered.

Processor reports

22. Each processor shall supply the Board with a report of each producer's deliveries and the amount of levies collected in a form acceptable to the Board.

Establishment of provincial quota

23. The Board, from time to time, shall determine the amount of quota needed to produce sufficient milk to meet the province's quota share.

Quota allocation

24. The Board shall allocate the provincial quota to all registered quota holders based on a percentage of their quota holdings compared to the total provincial quota holdings.

Quota adjustments

25. The Board may adjust producer quotas at any time to reflect an increase or decrease in the quota allocated to the province, market conditions or production variances.

Pro Rata

26. Where a quota adjustment is necessary, such adjustments shall be assessed, pro rata to all registered quota holders.

Cancellation of quota

27. The Board may cancel all or part of a producer's quota where the producer has contravened any Order of the Board.

Revocation

28. Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Order DFPEI 2009-07, is hereby revoked.

Commencement

29. This Order comes into force on 1 November 2010.

Application 1. This Order provides for the establishment of prices for each kilogram of butterfat, protein and other solids contained in milk used in the classes described in the Board's Classification of Milk Order.

Definitions 2. The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the Prince Edward Island Natural Products Marketing Act and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations unless differentiated herein and as hereinafter defined:

(a) "CMSMC" shall mean the Canadian Milk Supply Management Committee.

(b) "P5 Target Price" shall mean the prices established for components utilized in each milk class by the five provinces, party to the Agreement on the Eastern Canadian Milk Pooling, that are used as references for all price determinations within the pool.

Component Prices

3. The prices to be paid to Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island by processors for each kilogram of butterfat, protein and other solids contained in milk marketed within quota, and the standard billing factors, in kilograms per hectolitre of milk, for components used in the manufacture of Class 1 Milk products shall be as follows:

Under the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations and under the *Natural Products Marketing Act*, R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. N-3, Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island makes the following Order:

**MILK PRODUCER QUOTA EXCHANGE ORDER**

Application 1. This Order provides for the establishment, control and operation by the Board of a Quota Exchange to be operated for milk producers.

Definitions 2. The words herein shall have the meanings as found in the Prince Edward Island *Natural Products Marketing Act* and the Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island Regulations unless differentiated herein, and as hereinafter defined:

and (a) "cleared" shall mean the process by which the Board shall conduct the buying and selling of quotas which results in the purchase and sale of quotas.

(b) "daily quota" shall mean the amount of kilograms of butterfat quota assigned to a producer by the Board, expressed to two decimal places.

(c) "exchange month" shall mean the calendar month in which a producer's quota shall be adjusted by the amount of quota purchased or sold on the exchange.

(d) "market clearing price" shall be the price at which the amount of quota offered for sale on an exchange equals, or comes closest to, the amount of quota bid for, except that where the volume is the same for more than one price, the lowest price shall be used.

Exchange  
established

3. The Board hereby establishes a quota exchange, to be operated by the Board, for the purchase and sale of daily quota held by milk producers.

Eligible producers

4. Only producers registered by the Board shall be eligible to participate on the quota exchange.

Offer prices

5. The price at which milk producers may offer to sell or purchase quota on the exchange is limited to a maximum of twenty nine thousand dollars (\$29,000.00) per Kg of daily quota for the exchange operating in December 2009 that results in quota transfers effective 1 January 2010. The maximum price that milk producers may offer to sell or purchase quota on the exchange will decrease by one hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) per month each month (as detailed in Appendix A to this order) until the maximum price reaches twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) for the exchange operating in the month of August 2012. The maximum price that milk producers may offer to sell or purchase quota on the exchange will then continue at twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) unless amended by the Board.

Bids to be  
Excluded

6. Any bid to purchase or sell quota that exceeds the monthly maximum specified in this order (as detailed in Appendix A) shall be excluded from the exchange and returned to the bidder.

Offer amounts

7. Producers may offer to sell or purchase any amount of daily quota in increments of 0.1 kilograms, except when a producer is exiting the industry he may sell all quota measured to two decimal places. A producer may not offer to sell more than the amount of the seller's quota holdings.

Offer forms

8. Producers offering to sell or purchase quota on the exchange shall only submit offers on a form provided by, or approved by, the Board.

Delivery of forms

9. Offers to sell or purchase quota must be received at the Board Office by the close of business on the 15th of the month prior to the exchange month. The Board will accept a facsimile copy of an offer to sell or purchase quota on or prior to the close of business on the 15th of the month, provided that the producer mails an original signed copy of the form to the Board within one day of the facsimile copy being sent.

Weekends and  
holidays

10. Where the 15<sup>th</sup> of a month falls on a weekend or a statutory holiday, the Board shall accept offers to sell or purchase quota up to the close of business on the next business day.

Change or  
cancellation  
of offers

11. A producer may change or cancel an offer to sell or purchase quota provided that such change or cancellation is made in writing and the notice of change or cancellation is received at the board office prior to the close of business on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month prior to the exchange month.

Determination of  
market clearing  
price

12. Offers to sell and bids to purchase quota shall be used to establish the market clearing price of the exchange in the following manner:

(1) Offers to sell quota shall be accumulated based on the prices at which the quota is offered for sale, from the lowest to the highest price offered.

(2) Offers to purchase shall be accumulated based on the prices at which producers have bid for quota, from the highest price to the lowest bid price.

(3) If no point is reached where the amount of quota offered for sale is equal to, or nearly equals, the amount of quota bid for on an exchange, the exchange shall be deemed to have not cleared and no transactions shall take place on that exchange.

Selection process

13. Where the amount of quota offered for sale and bid for at the clearing price does not equal, the Board shall distribute the available quota in the following manner:

(1) If the amount of quota offered for sale at or below the clearing price is greater than the amount of quota bid for at the clearing price, the Board shall sell the quota offered for sale based on the order in which the offers to sell were received at the board office.

(2) If the amount of quota bid for at or above the clearing price is greater than the amount of quota offered for sale at the clearing price, the amount of quota sold shall be distributed in 0.01 kilogram lots until the amount of quota offered for sale at or below the clearing price is fully distributed.

(3) If a registered producer submits more than one bid to purchase quota then the registered producer's bids, which are at or above the clearing price, will be cumulated and considered as one bid for the distribution of quota as described in section 13 (2) (above).

Clearing date

14. The Board shall establish the clearing price, clear the exchange and release the exchange results by noon of the second business day following the last day the bids for the exchange are accepted.

Settlements

15. Producers offering to purchase quota on an exchange shall provide the Board with one of the following:

(1) A cheque, payable to the Board, which covers the full amount of the offer to purchase, plus the appropriate service charge, dated no later than the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month prior to the exchange month, or

(2) A letter from a reputable financial institution or legal firm that indicates the amount of the offer to purchase will be paid to the Board on the date required.

Purchases in  
excess of \$25,000

16. Where the offer to purchase exceeds \$25,000, the producer shall provide the Board with a letter from a responsible financial institution which indicates that the producer has made the necessary financial arrangements to have the cheque honoured on presentation by the Board.

Deposit of cheques

17. The Board shall deposit cheques for successful purchases on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the

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	month prior to the exchange month except that where the 25 <sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend or a statutory holiday the Board shall deposit the cheques on the next business day.
Settlements to purchasers	18. The Board shall issue settlements to purchasers of quota for overpayments on the tenth (10 <sup>th</sup> ) day of the exchange month.
Settlements to sellers	19. The Board shall issue settlements to sellers of quota on the tenth (10 <sup>th</sup> ) day of the exchange month.
Adjustments to producer quotas	20. The Board shall debit sellers quota with the amount of quota sold and credit purchasers quota with the amount of quota purchased on the 1st day of the exchange month.
Service charges	21. Producers shall pay to the Board a service charge of \$3.00 for each successful offer to sell or purchase quota and for each change in an offer as provided for in Section 11.
Failure to pay for quota	22. Where a producer fails to pay the Board for the amount of quota purchased, or where a cheque provided to the Board by a producer in payment of quota purchased has been dishonoured by a financial institution, the Board shall offer a sufficient amount of the producer's quota on the next exchange to clear the total amount owing to the Board, at the clearing price of that exchange, provided the producer has not paid the Board by the exchange clearing date.
Unsuccessful offers	23. Producers who are not successful in purchasing quota on an exchange shall have their cheques returned to them on the day the exchange clears.
Accounting	24. The Board shall maintain accounting records for the operation of the exchange and shall submit audited financial statements on the records of the exchange at its annual meeting and make an accounting of its operation based on the fiscal year of the Board.
Revocation	25. Dairy Farmers of Prince Edward Island order DFPEI 2009-08 dated 27 November 2009 is hereby revoked.
Commencement	26. This Order comes into force on 1 November 2010.
